HE'S IN CHARGE

MR. JAMES CATTLIN, 44-year-old yarn salesman from Rochdale, served a long "apprenticeship" — 21 years — in the Lancashire Combination before he was appointed to the Football League list of referees in 1960.

He has also been a familiar figure on the cricket grounds of Lancashire, having played 29 seasons in the Central Lancashire League, ten of them with Rochdale and 19 with Castleton Moor.

During the war, Mr. Cattlin served as a pilot in R.A.F. Transport Command.
