

Originally a wing-half, he has been converted into a hard-hitting inside-forward with a flair for snapping up chances. He scored 32 goals last winter, and this season has eight to his credit in League games, with a further three in the League Cup.

John Byrom made a great impression when first introduced to the Blackburn senior side at the age of 17 in 1961-62. He then dropped out of the limelight for two seasons, and only recently made a "come-back" as leader of the attack. Just how well he has played is shown by his total of six goals in eight League outings.

### Douglas's New Role

The mainspring of the attack is Bryan Douglas, who gained 36 England caps in his old position at outside-right. In recent seasons he has played mainly at inside-forward for the Rovers, where his brilliant scheming has provided countless openings for his fellow-forwards. Douglas played his 341st League game last Saturday.

Mike Harrison gained England Under-23 recognition while with us, and his displays since moving to Ewood Park have made him one of the most effective wingers Blackburn have had. Of his three League goals this season, two were from penalties.
