Saturday, April 8: **Chelsea 2** (Hollins, Garland), **Crystal Palace 1** (Blyth). Half-time: 1-0. Attendance: 34,105.

We took the lead seconds before half-time when, from Peter Osgood's centre, John Dempsey headed against a post and John Hollins, almost under the bar, scored his 18th goal of the season.

Chris Garland shot our second (74 mins.) from Charlie Cooke's centre, and Mel Blyth replied ten minutes from time.

Victory gave us our first League double against Palace—in November we had won 3-2 at Selhurst Park (scorers Tommy Baldwin, Alan Hudson, Peter Osgood for Chelsea; John Hughes and Gerry Queen for Palace).
